Part One: Beyond the “Now Age”

The premise:

A consistent literal, grammatical, and historical interpretation of the Scriptures leads to “Dispensationalism.”

What is dispensationalism?

The word dispensationalism comes from the Greek word for a “steward.” Three things are involved:

- 1) A M_____ : who gives a responsibility to the steward.
- 2) A S_____ : who receives a responsibility from his master.
- 3) And S _____ : responsibility--what must be accounted for.


Dispensationalists advocate

- 1) G_____ is the Master—he gives responsibilities (the employer) ... the “Dispenser!”
- 2) M_____ is the steward—mankind receives responsibilities (the employee) ... the “dispensee!”
- 3) D_____ = the responsibility given (steward-ship) (the employment)...the “dispensation!”


Now, because God gave His revelation “P_____” (not a single installment!) there are distinguishable economies (dispensations) in which He gave different responsibilities to mankind. This is most easily developed with a chart:


Rapture

The term "rapture" is from the Latin Vulgate (*rapiemur*) for "caught up" in 1 Thes 4:17.



Revelation

The word "revelation" is used for both the last B _____ of the Bible and the grand E _____ of that book: the return of Christ to the earth to establish His kingdom (Rev. 19:11).



Resurrection


Two Kinds:

1-Resurrection to L_____

John 5:28-29 "Do not be amazed at this, for a time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice 29 and come out-- those who have done good will rise to live, and those who have done evil will rise to be condemned.

Takes place in phases: Resurrection Program


- 1- Christ's (first fruits) 1 Cor 15:20
- 2- Rapture (at Christ's coming) 1 Cor 15:51-52; 1 Thes 4:16-17
- 3- Tribulation Saints (end of Trib) Daniel 12:2; Rev 20:3-5
- 4- Millennial Saints



2-Resurrection to D_____

John 5:29 "those who have done evil will rise to be condemned."

Revelation 20:12-15 12 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne ... The dead were judged 15 If anyone's name was not found written in the **book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.**



Millennium

The Word “millennium” is not found in the Bible!

- The Latin *mille* = 1,000 + the Latin *annus* = year
- The Greek = *chilia* occurs only in Rev. 20:2,3

It refers to a 1,000 year reign of the Christ over a literal KINGDOM of God on the earth.

Various views include:


- P____-Millennialism -- Holds that the return of Christ will be BEFORE a literal 1,000 year reign as king over a literal kingdom on earth.



- P____-Millennialism-- Holds that the return of Christ will be AFTER a literal 1,000 year reign of righteousness is brought about by the church as the kingdom of God



- A-Millennialism -- Holds that the return of Christ will be W_____ because kingdom of Christ is spiritual and is going on right now in the hearts of believers. There is no literal kingdom. The term “1,000 years” is symbolic for a long time.




Tribulation

The term “tribulation” is from the King James version of Matthew 24-25. It is used to refer to a future time of terrible D_____ to the world and Israel.

It will last seven years (Dan 9:27)

Other terms for it include:

- Daniels 70th “Seven” (“Week” KJV)
- the Day of the Lord (Ez 30:3)
- Time of Jacob’s Trouble (Jer 30:7)



GREAT-Tribulation

Refers to the S_____ - H_____ of the “tribulation” period and begins when the “abomination that causes desolation” appears in the temple. (Mat 24:15-24; Daniel 9:27).


Other references to the “great tribulation include:

- Time of Jacob’s trouble (Jer 30:7)
- Time, times and ½ time (Dan 12:7)
- 1,260 days (Rev 11:3)
- Great day of their wrath (Rev 6:17)




PRE-Tribulation

Means that the “rapture of the church” will take place B_____ the “tribulation” begins.



POST-Tribulation

Means that the “rapture of the church” will take place at the E_____ of or A_____ the “tribulation.”



MID-Tribulation

Means that the “rapture of the church” will take place in the M_____ of the “tribulation” period.



PRE-WRATH-Tribulation

Means that the “rapture of the church” will take place P_____ to the W_____ associated with the “tribulation” period.

PARTIAL-Tribulation



Means that only those waiting and watching for Christ will be taken in the rapture—those not ready will be left to endure the “tribulation” period.


JUDGMENT

1. The Judgment S_____ of Christ (For church-age believers!)
2. The Judgment of the N_____ (For survivors of Tribulation)
3. The Great W_____ Throne Judgment (For all un-judged at the end)

JUDGMENT SEAT OF CHRIST

Βηματος Place of R_____. (2 Cor 5:10; Rom 14:10; 1 Cor 3:9-15). Takes place in heaven.



No C_____ (Rom. 8:1) For the believer's condemnation was paid for at the cross!

1 Cor 3: 11 For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ. 12 If any man builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, 13 his work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each man's work. 14 If what he has built survives, he will receive his reward. 15 If it is burned up, he will suffer loss; he himself will be saved, but only as one escaping through the flames.


JUDGMENT OF THE NATIONS
