We are collecting the following items for HOPE Warming Center, serving homeless adults in Pontiac needing to get out of the elements.

H@PE shelters

HOPE was founded in 1998 as a seasonal warming center in response to the death of an individual from hypothermia who was not able to access shelter because he had been drinking. HOPE became a year-round low-barrier shelter (no sobriety requirement, no background check) in 2014

and then added a second shelter, HOPE Recuperative, in 2015.

Not only do they provide temporary warmth, but they also provide dinner, triage healthcare, showers, and access to resources that can be a pathway out of homelessness, significantly impacting the lives of those in need.
