





MARCH MISSION FOCUS-DRAW (DISASTER RELIEF AT WORK)



DRAW, located right here in Waterford, responds to floods, hurricanes, and tornadoes by providing supplies and volunteer services to help disaster victims

take their first steps back toward normalcy.

DRAW has the unique ability to get exactly what is needed into the hands of those who need it as quickly as possible. Over time, DRAW has honed its supply list to have the exact resources needed in the immediate aftermath of a storm. They assemble supplies into buckets tailored for each disaster, whether a tornado, flood, hurricane, or wildfire. Operations can get the needed supplies to the community hit by storms within 24-48 hours of the disaster.

DRAW needs your help to replenish their bucket supplies after their most recent response to the historic tornado outbreak across the eastern half of the U.S., which took the lives of dozens of people and left tens of thousands of others dealing with a major journey to recovery in multiple cities in Missouri, Mississippi, and Alabama.

Their top 5 greatest warehouse needs are currently:

- Quart size resealable bags
- Gallon size resealable bags
- 30-33 gallon standard trash bags
- 42+ gallon contractor bags
- Insect repellent

Other ways to help:

- Volunteer at the warehouse on any Wednesday.
