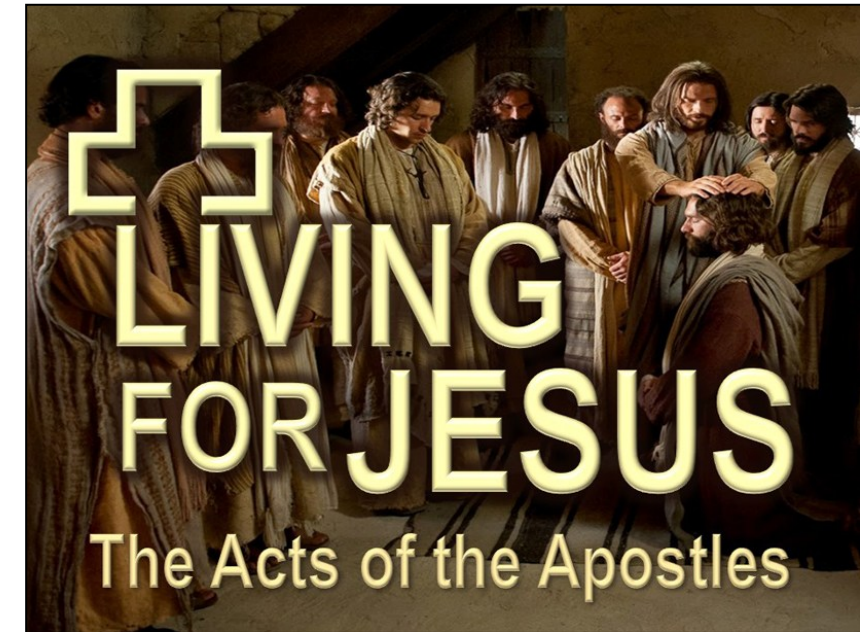
- Prayers for healing for Joyce Renfrow and God's guidance with her doctors and upcoming surgery. – Louise Aebersold
