
**Acts 17:1** When they had passed through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica, where there was a Jewish synagogue. <sup>2</sup> As his custom was, Paul went into the synagogue, and on **three Sabbath days** he reasoned with them from the Scriptures,

<sup>3</sup> explaining and proving that the Christ had to suffer and rise from the dead.



"This Jesus I am proclaiming to you is the Christ," he said. <sup>4</sup> Some of the Jews were persuaded and joined Paul and Silas, as did a large number of God-fearing Greeks and not a few prominent women. <sup>5</sup> But the Jews were jealous; so they rounded up some bad characters from the marketplace, formed a mob and started a riot in the city. They rushed to Jason's house in search of Paul and Silas in order to bring them out to the crowd. <sup>6</sup> But when they did not find them, they dragged



Jason and some other brothers before the city officials, shouting: "These men who have caused trouble all over the world have now come here, <sup>7</sup> and Jason has welcomed them into his house. They are all defying Caesar's decrees, saying that there is another king, one called Jesus." <sup>8</sup> When they heard this, the crowd and the city officials were thrown into turmoil. <sup>9</sup> Then they made Jason and the others post bond and let them go.

#### What can Paul say to that?

1 Thessalonians 1:1 Paul, Silas and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace and peace to you.

#### Next, he prays for them:

<sup>2</sup> We always thank God for all of you, mentioning you in our prayers. <sup>3</sup> We continually remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith, your labor prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.



Why he prays for them: 4 For we know, brothers loved by God, that he has chosen you,

#### **Eight Tell-Tale Signs that God Chose You!**

#### 1. You A\_\_\_\_\_ His Word

<sup>5</sup> because our gospel came to you not simply with words, but also with power, with the Holy Spirit and with deep conviction. You know how we lived among you for your sake.



#### 2. You I the Lord!

<sup>6</sup> You became imitators of us and of the Lord; in spite of severe suffering, you welcomed the message with the joy given by the Holy Spirit.



#### 3. **You M\_\_\_\_\_ the Faith!**

<sup>7</sup> And so you became a model to all the believers in Macedonia and Achaia.

#### 4. You P\_\_\_\_\_ the Word!

<sup>8</sup> The Lord's message rang out from you not only in Macedonia and Achaia--your faith in God has become known everywhere. Therefore we do not need to say anything about it, <sup>9</sup> for they themselves report what kind of

7. **L\_\_\_\_\_ makes us strong** 3:12-13





#### THE RAPTURE OF THE CHURCH

**The Problem:** D\_\_\_\_\_\_ 4:13

<sup>13</sup> Brothers, we do not want you to be ignorant about those who fall asleep, or to grieve like the rest of men, who have no hope.





**The Solution:** J\_\_\_\_\_\_R 4:14-15

<sup>14</sup> We believe that Jesus died and rose again and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him. <sup>15</sup> According to the Lord's own word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left till the coming of the Lord ...

The Dead are Raised F\_\_\_\_\_ 4:15

will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep.



## The Greatest Robbery of All Time is Coming! The Rapture of the Church 4:17



"we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together"


"Caught up" = Greek "harpagasometha"

Translated in Philippians 2:6 as "robbery"

The term "rapture" is from the Latin word "rapiemur" which means "caught up."

#### Four ideas contained in the word "rapture":

- 1) S\_\_\_\_\_ away speedily Acts 8:39
- 2) S\_\_\_\_\_ and carry off by force John 6:15
- 3) M\_\_\_\_\_ to a new place 2 Corinthians 12:1-4
- 4) R\_\_\_\_\_ from danger or destruction Acts 23:10

<sup>16</sup> For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God,



#### 1 Thessalonians 5:1-10

#### The text makes a huge transition at 5:1

#### 5:1 [But] Now,

Περι δε = "now concerning"

Q: Now concerning what?

A: The Day of the Lord

#### 1- Be I\_\_\_\_\_ of it 5:1-2

5:1 Now, brothers, about times and dates we do not need to write to you, 2 for you know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night.





2- Be E\_\_\_\_\_ of it 5:3

3 While people are saying, "Peace and safety," destruction will come on them suddenly, as labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.

#### 3- Be E\_\_\_\_\_ of it 5:4-5

4 But you, brothers, are not in darkness so that this day should surprise you like a thief. 5 You are all sons of the light and sons of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness.

#### 4- Be D\_\_\_\_\_\_ because of it 5:6-7

6 So then, let us not be like others, who are asleep, but let us be alert and self-controlled. 7 For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk, get drunk at night.





#### 5- Be A for it 5:8

8 But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation as a helmet.

#### 6- Be S\_\_\_\_\_ from it 5:9

9 For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.



#### 7- Be R before it 5:10



10 He died for us so that, whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with him.

Q: Where is Christ during the "Tribulation?"

A: IN H\_\_\_\_\_!

It's like this ...

We who have Jesus as our Savior will never, ever experience the W of God.

Not now—nor to come!

- <sup>17</sup> pray continually;
- <sup>18</sup> give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
- <sup>19</sup> Do not put out the Spirit's fire;
- <sup>20</sup> do not treat prophecies with contempt.
- <sup>21</sup> Test everything. Hold on to the good.
- <sup>22</sup> Avoid every kind of evil.

#### 4- Your God H

- <sup>23</sup> May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- <sup>24</sup> The one who calls you is faithful and he will do it.
